## Palo Verde Elementary School Uniform Policy 2015-2016

The Casa Grande Elementary School District has a dress code (J-2361-R) that students attending Palo Verde Elementary School will also be encouraged to follow.

- TOPS: Navy blue, white, or red, long or short-sleeved collared shirts and turtlenecks are options. Palo Verde spirit shirts are allowed on Fridays.
- BOTTOMS: Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, capris, and jumpers are acceptable. Blue jeans and shorts are permitted. Bottoms and jumpers should be at least fingertip length when arms are at the one's side.
- SOCKS: Navy blue or white socks, knee-highs, tights, and leggings (under jumpers, skirts) may be worn.
- SHOES: Closed-toe shoes are to be worn on P.E. days. Low-heeled sandals with a back strap are permitted, but flip-flops, slippers, shoes with a heel, and Heelies are not permitted.
- HATS: Hats may be worn outdoors, but are not to be worn in the building.
- OUTERWEAR: During the cold weather months, any color jacket, sweater, sweater vest, or sweatshirt is permitted for wear outside.
- OTHER ITEMS: Artificial nails, make-up, and hair that is dyed unnatural color are not permitted.

Every effort will be made to keep your child in school and make sure that they are wearing an acceptable version of the dress code. There may be instances where parents will need to be contacted to provide a change of clothing, if your child is not in uniform.
